

Fire Policy

It is my absolute priority to get all children to safety in the case of a fire, while they are in my care as quickly and as safely as possible.

I have in place two smoke detectors, one up stairs on the landing and one down stairs in the hallway, which I check regularly.

In the kitchen I have in place at all times a fire blanket, which would be replaced if ever used.

I have a fire escape plan on the wall in the lobby by the front door.

I will practice a fire drill at regular intervals with all the children I have in my care.

Procedure (how I will put the statement into practice)

If there is a fire:

- *First I will get the children to a place of safety as quickly and safely as possible.

- *I will have a meeting point at the end of the road, round to the left of Saffron Gardens.

- *I will ring 999 for the fire brigade.

- *I will reassure children in my care.

- *I will ring and inform all parents.
